

BOOK SYNOPSIS - LONG

It was the fall of 2016. A female business network had invited me to Johannesburg in South Africa to speak on entrepreneurship. I was surprised to see that after my talk, a long line of people formed. They wanted to hear more about my journey from high school dropout to serial entrepreneur. Many of them asked me if I had a book or if I had ever thought of writing one. I was flattered, but more importantly, I realized that I had so much more to tell than the forty-five minutes I had spent on the stage. The idea of writing something had been born. But it wasn't until a year and a half later, when I was in Boston, that I actually took the step to get started on this book. After my talk, a young woman—she was perhaps in her late twenties --came up to me and said: "After hearing this I've finally decided to start a business of my own." This made me feel strong and somehow successful. The fact that I, standing in a shiny office building in downtown Boston was treated with such respect for something that I believe in—to boost other women—was a dream I'd had for a long time and I was finally there, just by telling my story.

I realized that I had to do something more with this power to inspire; I needed to put these words down on paper so that I could share my story with more people. When I sat down to write, I thought I would be writing about entrepreneurship. I wanted to share my experiences as a female entrepreneur, the ups and downs, the challenges, the successes, the twists and turns, the details of the day to day of running companies with all that entails. But instead, during the process of writing, this book turned into something else. It turned into a memoir of sorts. During the process of writing, I discovered so many things about myself—things that I had never thought of before. At first, I was hesitant to include them in this book. It all seemed too personal. But then, I realized that all these events, all these moments that have impacted me in some way, all form an essential part of the story. I realized that there were some key moments that impacted the trajectory of my life and career, and they couldn't be easily separated into business or personal.

We aren't simple. We're multifaceted and complex creatures. And the fact is, if we're honest, we can't isolate business from the personal. Our productive lives in business are always somehow impacted by our personal lives. Many times, we wish this wasn't true. But there's no use in pretending that we're robots or minimizing the impact of family, friends and childhood experiences on our work life. In our lives, there are certain moments that matter more than others. These may be changing careers, having children or buying your first home. But for entrepreneurs, there's no job security or workplace to fall back on. Everything is your responsibility, and then, things are a little different. In my case, when I took the step to wholeheartedly dedicate myself to areas where I lacked the knowledge but had the drive and motivation, I was continually putting my life on the line. And this is the case for many entrepreneurs. These events that I realized were crucial for who I am, both as an entrepreneur, a woman, and a human being—are pivotal moments.

This book is my opportunity to serve others and give back. So many people that I have met from so many walks of life and so many corners of the world have given me energy, inspiration, and motivation. At this point in my life, I feel that it's not only my joy but also my duty to share my story, my struggles, my strengths, my weaknesses with you, with the hope of helping and maybe inspiring you in some way.


Unfortunately, we have too many walls between us in this world. We need to be more open with each other and tear many of these walls down. When we share our experiences, when we're open with ourselves, when we welcome others into our lives,

we don't only help them but help ourselves. We are all connected and interdependent, whether we're talking about the global economy, Fortune 500 companies, small businesses or our personal relationships.

I don't want to minimize the fact that life as an entrepreneur can be difficult and challenging. But the rewards can also be more significant than you can imagine. 


